HOSPITALS: COVID-10 SURGE AT MUSGRAVE AS CITY GETS READY

230 of sickest patients will be treated at tower block

SOUTH Belfast's two main hospitals have found themselves in the front line of the battle against Covid-19.

Inside today we reveal that there's been a significant leap in the number of cases confirmed at Musgrave Park

Hospital (right) – 16 people are now confirmed to have the virus there.

Meanwhile, two miles down the Lisburn Road the City Hospital is being readied for an expected surge in Covid-19 cases.

The Mater Hospital on the Crumlin Road was designated the lead facility in the city for Coronavirus, but the City has now been earmarked to provide beds for 230 of the sickest patients.
